

**OPIATE, URINE**  
**#8473**

**EXPLANATION:** In a recent Reporting Change announcement dated May 4, 2009, #89605, 6-Monoacetylmorphine (6-MAM), Urine, was announced as a reflex test for the determination of heroin use when the morphine concentration is  $>$  or  $=2000$  ng/mL.

With feedback received and upon further review, #89605, 6-MAM **will not automatically reflex**. A report comment will appear if the morphine concentration is  $>$  or  $=2000$ ng/mL, indicating additional testing recommended. This testing can then be added within 14 days by contacting Mayo Medical Laboratories.
