BATCH SHEET ANNOUNCEMENT

EXPLANATION: A situation has been discovered in the batch sheet processing for a small subset of tests listed in the table below. Beginning on November 18th, when closing the batch for these tests, two batch sheets will print – one for Rochester (RST) and one for New England (NEL). Both batch sheets will list the same profile test name.

When closing the batches with these test orders, we are asking your assistance by following this process:

- o Staple the two batch sheets together with the NEL batch sheet on the top
- o Group all specimens for the two batch sheets into one transport bag
- o Route the bag to Mayo New England
