Trypsin, Fecal

Reporting Title: Trypsin, F

Performing Location: ARUP Laboratories, Interface

Specimen Requirements:

5g of random stool. Send specimen frozen, on dry ice, in a plastic container.

Note: 1. Critical frozen. No freeze/thaws.

- 2. No preservative.
- 3. Time constricted. Frozen stability is only 1 week.
 - The stool sample for this test cannot be shared. If other testing is required, collect separate stool samples appropriate for those tests.

Greater than or equal to 1:96

A fecal trypsin titer greater than or equal to 1:96 is considered normal. Fecal trypsin is measured by serially diluting stool in buffer and identifying the greatest titer at which x-ray film is cleared of its gelatin emulsion.
