SPECIMEN REQUIREMENTS:

Container/Tube: Serum gel tube **Specimen volume:** 0.5 mL **Minimum volume:** 0.1 mL

	Refrigerated	24 hours

CAUTIONS: A negative test result does not exclude the presence of recent hepatitis E infection (<2 month duration), especially in immunocompromised patients. Repeat testing for antihepatitis E virus (HEV) IgM and anti-HEV IgG in 1 to 2 months is recommended for diagnosis of recent hepatitis E.
