A peritoneal fluid CEA concentration > 6.0 ng/mL is suspicious but not diagnostic of a malignant source of the ascites. This cutoff yielded 48% sensitivity, 99% specificity in a study of 137 patients presenting with ascites. CEA levels in peritoneal fluid are most informative when interpreted in conjunction with the CEA serum levels. Tumor marker tests are not specific for malignancy. This test result should be interpreted in the context of clinical presentation, imaging and cytology findings.

Values obtained with different assay methods or kits may be different and cannot be used interchangeably.

Test results cannot be interpreted as absolute evidence for the presence or absence of malignant disease.
