**Interpretation (GALT)**

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The galactose-1-phosphate uridyltransferase (GALT) activity in this sample is reduced, however, not consistent with classic galactosemia (GALT deficiency). This result can be explained by a variety of genotypes including carrier status (NG). If molecular genetic testing is desired, this could be done on the existing sample by calling MML within one month.
