Consistent with Pyruvate Kinase deficiency.

Clinically significant PK deficiency manifests in widely variable severity ranging from incidental compensated mild normocytic anemia to severe neonatal anemia. Other symptoms include jaundice, early gallstones and splenomegaly. Rare severe forms are associated with hydrops fetalis/fetal demise. Rarely, acquired PK deficiency can arise secondary to myeloid neoplasms. MH8
